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In Class We Are...

Reading

Students will review past skills and practice asking/answering questions, determining main idea and point of view for fiction/nonfiction texts.

Students will continue Daily 5 (Daily 3) by choosing their rotations each day and completing given assignment for read to self, work on writing, and word work.

Math

Students will tell and write time to the nearest minute and measure time intervals in minutes. Solve word problems involving addition and subtraction of time intervals in minutes, e.g., by representing the problem on a number line diagram

Students will close read word problems and directions identifying key words and important details.

Science/ Social Studies

Students will understand how plants survive in their environments, remember plant structures and their function, and explain the life cycle and conditions needed for plants to grow.

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
