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## In Class We Are...

### Reading

Students will review past skills and practice asking/answering questions, determining main idea and point of view for fiction/nonfiction texts.

Students will continue Daily 5 (Daily 3) by choosing their rotations each day and completing given assignment for read to self, work on writing, and word work.

### Math

Students will review past skills including: identifying shape attributes, area/perimeter, rounding, adding/subtracting 3 digit numbers, multiplying/dividing, time, measurement of capacity and length, picture graphs and line plots

Students will close read word problems and directions identifying key words and important details.

### Science/ Social Studies

Students will understand entrepreneurship in a market economy and how location of regions affects activity in a market economy.

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
