Reading

Students will continue Daily 5 (Daily 3) by choosing their rotations each day and completing given assignment for read to self, work on writing, and word work. We will focus on their book clubs and analyzing characters. Students will begin writing their third opinion on a fruit/vegetable.

Students will use properties of multiplication and division (commutative, associative, and distributive) as well as solve multiplication and division word problems using more than one step.
