In Class We Are...

Reading

Students will continue Daily 5 (Daily 3) by choosing their rotations each day and completing given assignment for read to self, work on writing, and word work.

Math

Students will interpret products of whole numbers as well as fluently multiply and divide within 100 using strategies or properties of operations. Students will also apply properties of operations as strategies to multiply and divide (commutative, associative, distributive).

Students will close read word problems and directions identifying key words and important details.

Science/ Social Studies

Students will recognize the major components and patterns observed in the Earth/Moon/Sun System, explain causes of day/night and phases of the moon.
