In Class We Are...

Reading

Students will read and analyze characters, motivations, and POV in biographies. Students will continue Daily 5 (Daily 3) by choosing their rotations each day and completing given assignment for read to self, work on writing, and word work.

Math

Students will recognize & understand concepts of perimeter and area measurement (unit squares, length, width). Students will also recognize & understand fractions as part of a whole and on a number line.

Students will close read word problems and directions identifying key words and important details.
