Reading

Students will read and analyze characters, motivations, and POV in biographies. Students will continue Daily 5 (Daily 3) by choosing their rotations each day and completing given assignment for read to self, work on writing, and word work.

Students should continue to use their close reading bookmark for reading homework packets. A digital copy is available on my website if needed

Math

Students will draw scaled picture and bar graphs, as well as solve one and two step how many more/less problems using that data. Students will recognize & understand concepts of area measurement (unit squares, length, width).

Students will close read word problems and directions identifying key words and important details.
