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## In Class We Are...

### Reading

Students will read and analyze mysteries to explain how illustrations relate to text. Students will also describe how each successive part builds on an earlier section or chapter.

Students will continue Daily 5 (Daily 3) by choosing their rotations each day and completing given assignment for read to self, work on writing, and word work.

Students will recognize & understand fractions as part of a whole, on a number line, and begin explaining equivalence of fractions such as  $1/2 = 2/4$

### Math

Students will close read word problems and directions identifying key words and important details.

### Science/ Social Studies

Students will understand the earth's patterns by using the 5 themes of geography (location, place, human-environment interaction, movement, and regions)

Students will also understand how diverse cultures are visible in local and regional communities

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
