## In Class We Are...

### Reading

Students will continue Daily 5 (Daily 3) by choosing their rotations each day and completing given assignment for read to self, work on writing, and word work. We will focus on their book clubs and analyzing characters. Students will begin writing their second opinion piece of their choice. \*Students should continue to use their close reading bookmark for reading homework packets. A digital copy is available on my website if needed\*

Students will identify arithmetic patterns (including patterns in the addition table or multiplication table). They will also determine the unknown whole number in a multiplication or division equation relating three whole numbers.

### Math

Students will close read word problems and directions identifying key words and important details.

### Science/ Social Studies

Students will recognize the major components and patterns observed in the Earth/Moon/Sun System, explain causes of day/night and phases of the moon.
